Week 6: This week we continue learning about the special season of Advent. Week 2, we light the candle of Peace. We will be talking to the children about what peace means and how we can share it with each other.





Reminder:

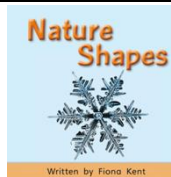

Bug Club – Nature Shapes –

Quiet and loud!
 Show page 8 of the book Nature Shapes and say “Shell starts with /sh/”. To Sit together in a circle and explain that you are going to play a speaking and listening game. One person starts by saying a word quietly to the person next to them and then this person says the word loudly!


Challenge children to think of different words to say in different ways. Encourage them to repeat words back in the same way that they were said to them. Extend by asking them all to copy the opposite way, so if someone says a word quietly, can everyone say it loudly?

Ask the children to share their experiences of Christmas. What is Christmas like in other places around the world? Use a map to highlight different places.</p>	<p><u>Small World Area</u> Nativity- Set up these Christmas Small World Characters in a large activity tray. Encourage the children to develop a story while playing with them.</p>	<p><u>Outdoor Area</u> Bikes, trikes, chalk, building using bricks, tyres and crates. Create a track for bikes and cars Turn a scooter into a reindeer by decorating it with a red nose and jingle bells. Encourage the children to ride the 'reindeer' around the outdoor area. Using tape, make a Christmas tree shape on the ground out of straight lines. Provide children with a star and baubles. Can the children balance themselves and walk along the tree, placing down the star and baubles?</p>
